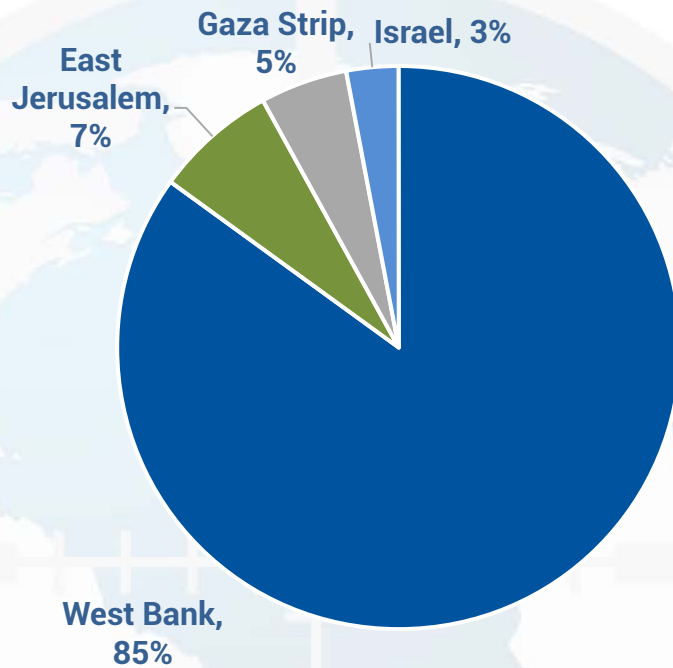

Terror Prevention Within Prisons

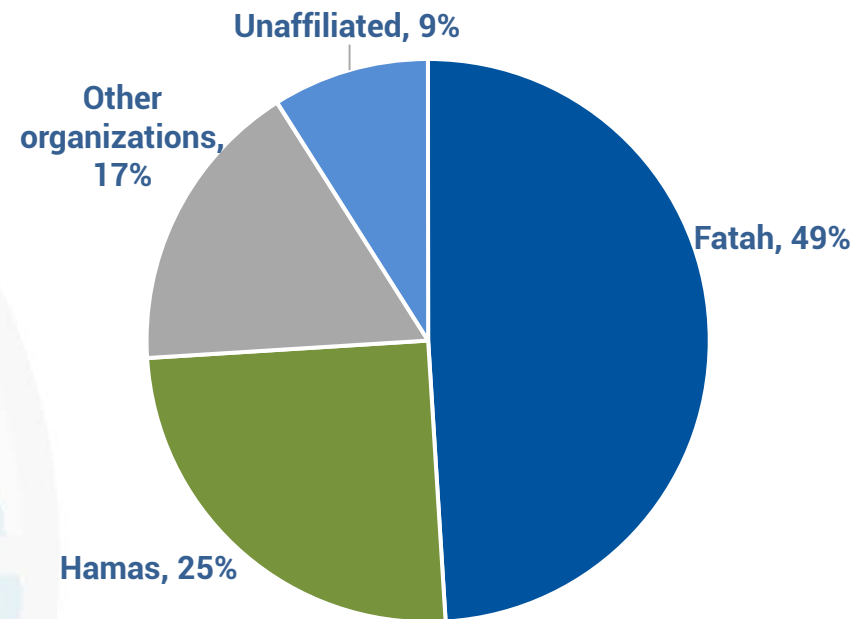
- In the IPS there are currently 5,663 terror prisoners:
 - Convicted – 3,416
 - Pre-Trial – 2,247
- They are held in 7 detention facilities across Israel

- Providing secure custody
- Providing appropriate custody
- Protecting the public
- implementing rules and conventions

Rules and conventions that influence incarceration

- The 4th Geneva convention
- Red Cross: Family visits
- Terror inmates are not entitled to correctional treatment, as opposed to criminal prisoners
- Living Space Ruling: to be expanded to 4.5 meters, as per all IPS prisoners

Practices of collecting intelligence within prison



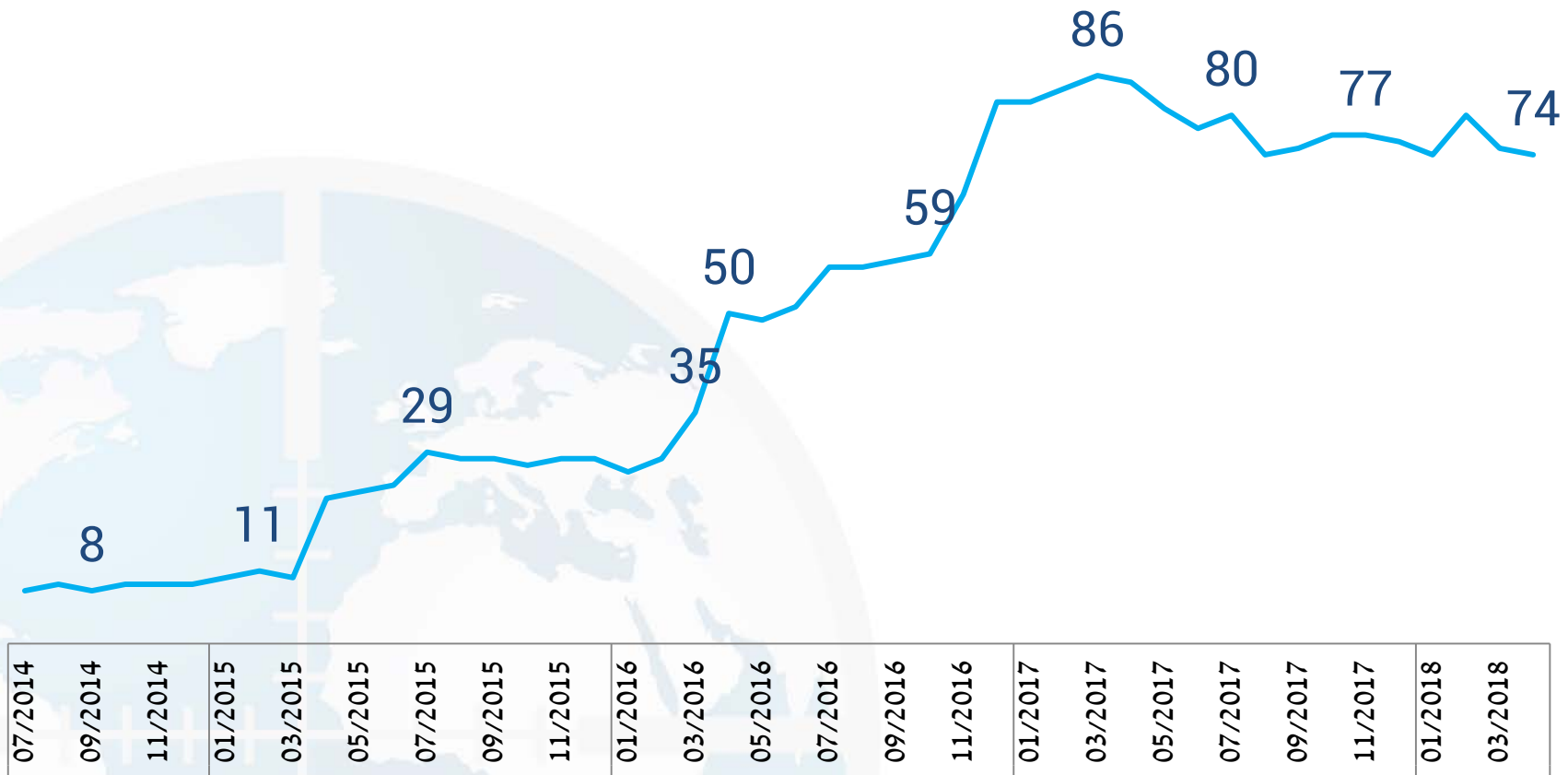
- IPS intelligence – the development of a mechanism that is unique to the IPS
- Cooperation between intelligence organizations in Israel
- Use of varied means: HUMINT, SIGINT, VISINT, OSINT

The separation of the outside world from the prison walls



- Reducing contact with the outside to the bare minimum and keeping it controlled
- Isolating leaders and negative influences
- Supporting moderates
- Efforts to prevent the overspill of violence from the Palestinian street into the prison

Deterrence – the carrot and stick approach

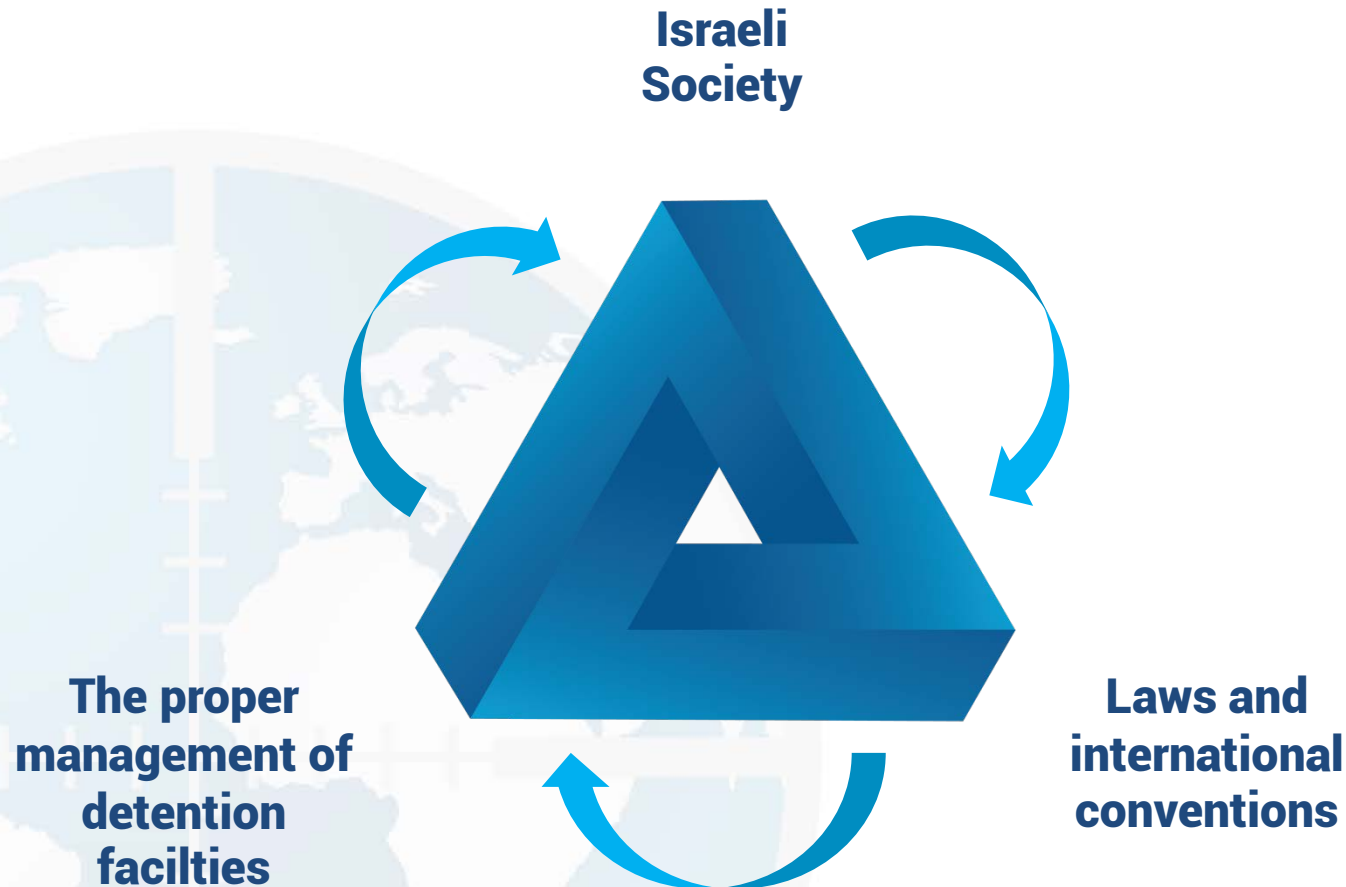


- Providing a clear understanding that certain benefits are contingent on behavior
- 20 hours in cells, 4 hours in the yard
- Use of operational abilities: special forces for searches and deterrence

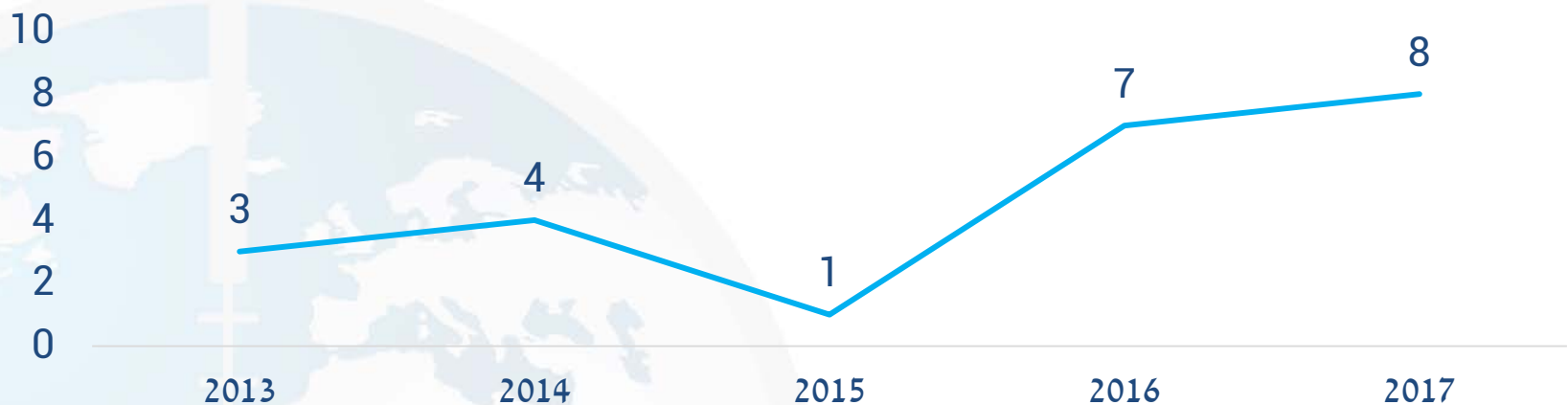
The triangle of influence in holding terror inmates

- Planning and directing terror actions

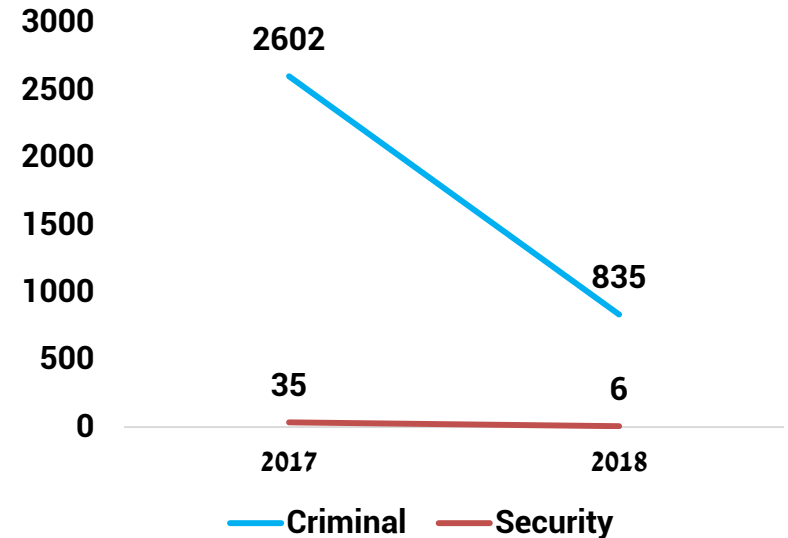


- Staff attacks and detecting weapons (security and criminal)

Attacks on staff



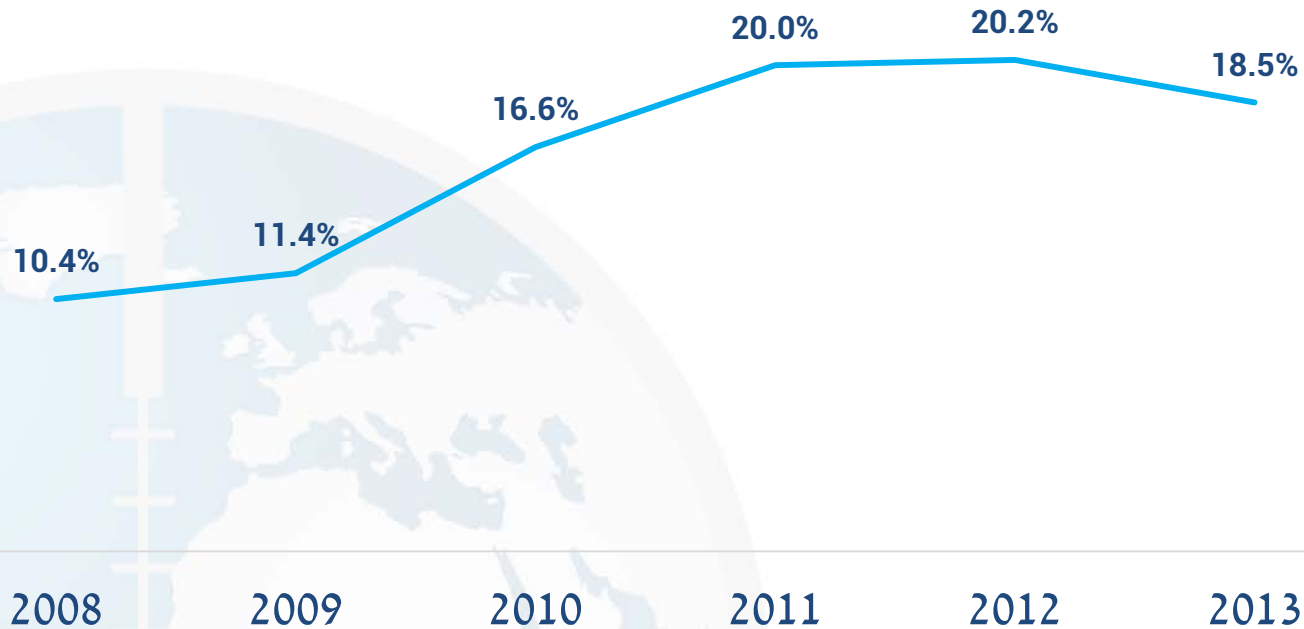
Weapon detections
